

SCHOOLS

In 1846, there were 3 schools in the parish: recently established 'private adventure' schools at Woodend and Cater's Hook Gate, and St. Issell's National School held in a school house in the churchyard. This school had been established in 1745 and the building is still there today. Saundersfoot British School was opened on 10th January 1870, became the Community Centre but closed. The present village school was opened 11th December 1973

SAUNDERSFOOT BRITISH SCHOOL

This school was opened as a non-denominational British School on Monday, 10th January 1870. It served the Community for a century but was replaced by the present primary school, in Francis Lane, in 1973. The former school building was used as a Community Educational Centre, in the ownership of the local authority into the first decade of the 21st century, but was out of use by 2010. A large former playground exists to the rear of the building.
